RULES/REQUIREMENTS AND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT FORM

1. Contestants must be the ages 6 - 10 years old by the 2026 Pageant.
2. Must be a U.S. Citizen. Contestant, Parent or Legal Guardian must currently be a resident of Stephenson County IL or the contestant is attending a Stephenson County school. Contestants from another county may compete if their county does not have a pageant for their age division or if approved by the Stephenson County Fair Board.
3. Anyone holding a current title (having a crown and/or sash) will not be eligible to participate.
4. Born male and have always been male.
5. Contestants who are under the age of 18 must have parent's/legal guardian's written consent agreeing to the rules and exceptions. (See rehearsal schedule for additional details).
6. Each contestant will be personally interviewed on Tuesday, July 21, 2026 by the judges in church attire (button up shirt, polo, dress jeans, slacks, khaki shorts, boat shoes, loafers, dress boots, etc).
7. Each contestant will appear on stage in a the dress attire listed above with shoes of his choice Formal pageant type attire is optional.
8. All clothing must be approved by the Pageant Director by June 20, 2026. A picture will be taken for documentation. Once the clothing is approved NO changes will be allowed.
9. Rehearsals will be on Sunday afternoons from 4:00 pm to about 5:00 pm and you will be provided a schedule once your registration form is received. Rehearsals are subject to change so please be sure to attend each practice. We understand that summer vacations may happen but it is also very important to be committed to the pageant. If you have over 2 absences you will be eliminated from the competition. If you are going to be absent you are to contact the director by noon (12:00 pm) the day of rehearsal.
10. Contestants will be judged as follows: Personal Interviews, Questions and stage presence in knee-length dress.
11. It is prohibited for the 2026 Stephenson County Fair Little Mister to participate in any other scholarship or beauty pageants during his reign. If he chooses to do so, he will be required to give up his title and all that goes with it (crown, sash, pin, all gifts and scholarship) to the next eligible Runner-up. This will disqualify him from competing in the Stephenson County Fair Little Mister Pageant in the future.
12. The newly selected Little Mister will assist the newly crowned Prince as hostess of the Stephenson County Fair, July 21-26, 2026. An itinerary of duties for the week of the Stephenson County Fair will be given to the Little Mister by the pageant committee.
13. The newly crowned Little Mister agrees to participate in all functions becoming of a Little Mister. This includes all parades, and other events which may arise during the year. Activities connected with the Stephenson County Fair should take precedence over and above all other personal appearances. All personal appearances as the Stephenson County Fair Little Mister shall be approved in advance by the Pageant Director; as well as any photographic sessions and pictures released as the role of Stephenson County Fair Little Mister.

14. The newly crowned Little Mister will be chaperoned either by the Pageant Director, or a chaperone approved by the Director at any time he is representing the Stephenson County Fair. Any event outside the fair at least one parent or guardian must attend the event with their child.
15. Decisions of the judges are final. Any grievances or objections relative to the contest will be referred to the Pageant Committee or the Stephenson County Fair Board. Each judge will sign an affidavit stating that they do not know, are not related to, nor do they or have they ever coached any of the Little Mister contestants competing this year.
16. Scores will not be given out to contestants after the pageant. If you would like feedback or have any questions, please contact the Pageant Director for details.
17. If there are not more than two (2) contestants in this category, a first runner up will not be announced.



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Judging Categories

PERSONAL INTERVIEWS: are timed events – up to four (4) minutes for each contestant. Contestants will be asked a series of simple questions by a panel of judges. The girls will be asked things like their favorite food at the fair, favorite ride at the fair, about their family and a few other general questions. The judges are looking for a contestant who is outgoing and unafraid of speaking.

ON-STAGE MODELING: Each contestant will be guided through a simple modeling sequence for onstage. They will introduce themselves by saying their name and the city they are from into the microphone. They are asked to wear dress attire of their choice, remember to allow your son to choose an outfit in which he feels comfortable in. This outfit does not have to be a formal/pageant attire. The girls are judged on their stage presence and how they model the attire; they are not judged on the dress. You will see all types of attire from fancy, Church, School to casual khaki shorts. Again, it needs to be something that your son feels great in and loves! Our pageant is strictly for fun; please keep the attire and hairstyles age appropriate.

Crown Bowl Question's: Each contestant will be asked three questions by the current Queen on stage. Questions will be given out in advance so that the contestants have time to practice their answers.

****A \$40 entry fee is required from each contestant and due on the registration deadline (or at the latest the informational meeting on June 1st, 2026)**

****A Bio/Questionnaire is due by the second rehearsal on Saturday June 20th, 2026. Please feel free to contact the director with any questions regarding the pageant or rehearsals. She can be flexible but need to be fair to all and I need commitment from all of our contestants. Our most important goal is to have fun, so come join us!**
